Overview:

The United Nations system has embarked on an action-oriented and coordinated effort to support the international community in addressing the challenge of climate change.

Together, the UN system organizations has established a clear Action Framework with 10 targeted priority areas under the umbrella of the Chief Executives Board (CEB). Each agency contributes to this joint effort on the basis of its area of expertise, intergovernmental mandate and available resources. The overall objective of the CEB Climate Change Action Framework is to maximize existing synergies, eliminate duplication and overlap, and optimize the impact of the collective efforts of the UN system in supporting countries implementing strategies to address climate change.
